

How to reset Costview 3.5.2

Clean / Password reset / Auto export

To reset Costview , you can do it by modifying the URL.
Open a web browser and type:

localhost/costview3/your_script.php or *192.168.0.134/costview3/your_script.php*

1) CLEAN "___cleancv.php"

it will delete all the data in the database: jobs, printers, rips, media, inks, resolution speed, cutters, etc ...

After this clean, all the jobs already treated will not be gotten anymore.

2) RESET PASSWORD "___reset_password.php"

it will delete the password in the configuration file if your customer lose it.

If the password is not set, it will be mandatory for your customer to reset it, any other access will be impossible.

Open a web browser and type

http://<adresse_ip>/costview3/___reset_password.php

ou http://localhost/costview3/___reset_password.php

3) AUTO EXPORT "auto_export.php"

it will run the auto_export process for CSV right now in the case you want to demonstrate the auto_export feature.

Put an auto_export profile with "every hour" parameter, run this script, and the export will be generated and downloadable.

It will not work for parameters "every day", "every month", etc ...
