

## **How to reset Costview 3.5.2 Clean / Password reset / Auto export**

To reset Costview , you can do it by modifying the URL.

Open a web browser and type:

*localhost/costview3/your\_script.php* or *192.168.0.134/costview3/your\_script.php*

### **1) CLEAN "\_\_\_\_cleancv.php"**

it will delete all the data in the database: jobs, printers, rips, media, inks, resolution speed, cutters, etc ...

After this clean, all the jobs already treated will not be gotten anymore.

### **2) RESET PASSWORD "\_\_\_\_reset\_password.php"**

it will delete the password in the configuration file if your customer lose it.

If the password is not set, it will be mandatory for your customer to reset it, any other access will be impossible.

Open a web browser and type

[http://<adresse\\_ip>/costview3/\\_\\_\\_\\_reset\\_password.php](http://<adresse_ip>/costview3/____reset_password.php)  
ou [http://localhost/costview3/\\_\\_\\_\\_reset\\_password.php](http://localhost/costview3/____reset_password.php)

### **3) AUTO EXPORT "auto\_export.php"**

it will run the auto\_export process for CSV right now in the case you want to demonstrate the auto\_export feature.

Put an auto\_export profile with "every hour" parameter, run this script, and the export will be generated and downloadable.

It will not work for parameters "every day", "every month", etc ...
